Healthcare is one of the most dynamic and rapidly growing industries in the country.

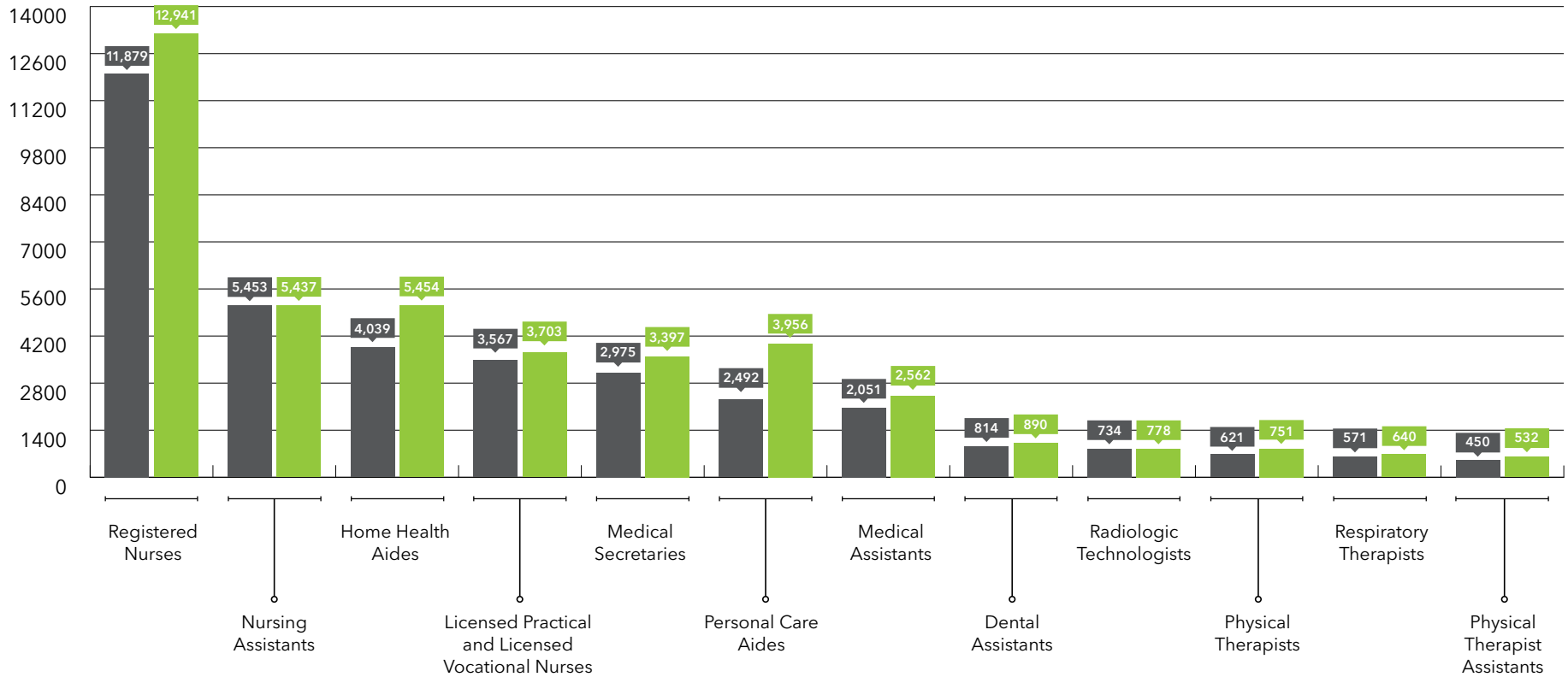
